

Lee Street Park Rules



Lee Street Park is a public space, and visitors should be respectful of themselves, others, and park property. The following rules and regulations are provided to ensure that your visit is pleasant and enjoyable. These policies are maintained in consideration of our guests and to protect the resources within Lee Street Park. Please be sure that all members of

your party are aware of these conditions prior to arrival. While this abridged listing does not include all regulations pertaining to activities in state parks, it does address some of the more common questions and concerns. There are some specific regulations governing behavior in parks that we would like to emphasize.

- Low profile, beach-style chairs: On the general admission sloped lawn ONLY. Out of respect for fellow concert-goers, chair legs must be no higher than 5" off of the ground and chair backs no higher than 27" off the ground. Chairs higher than low profile, beach style chairs (no more than 5" off the ground) will not be allowed into the venue.
- Blankets: limited to beach towel size only.
- Purses, bags, and backpacks: May be subject to search by security personnel prior to entering the venue.
- Rain coats or ponchos, small umbrellas
- Small, non-professional cameras with a 'no-flash' setting
- Outdoor cooking is prohibited except in areas where a city grill has been provided for public use. (Exception: authorized outdoor festival or special event vendors.)
- Tents and canopies 10' are prohibited
- Driving of stakes, posts or poles for any reason (including erecting tents or other structures) is forbidden



- No motorized vehicles are allowed, except for use by emergency and festival personnel. No bicycle, motorcycle, or moped riding is allowed during event times. No skateboard riding or roller-skating is allowed during event times.
- No playing of portable radios, musical instruments or similar devices that are plainly audible to others in the park, unless part of event programming.
- Glass containers are prohibited in parks.
- Absolutely no drugs or illegal substances allowed on City property.
- The sale or distribution of alcoholic beverages in City parks is strictly prohibited unless a special license and insurance are obtained.
- Alcohol is allowed in the park; however, obnoxious behavior or excessive noise will not be permitted.
- Attendees are responsible for the conduct of all group members.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in parking lots, band-shells, or kiddie land areas.
- When asked, attendees must show id when consuming alcoholic beverages.
